Registration procedure

If you have return your university card form and activated your university IT account (SSO), you can now start the registration procedure.

- 1) Register online by logging into Student Self-Service using your SSO.
- 2) Book an appointment (you need your SSO to log-in) to meet with a member of the Academic Office, either myself or Caroline Mawson. You will collect your university card from us. We are also happy to answer your queries. If you think you need more than 10 mins, please book more than one slot. If you are part-time and/or will not be in Oxford, please request for an online meeting. You do not have to come see me again if you have met me in person in the last few weeks.
- 3) Bring your BRP ID card and passport to the appointment. We are working on a site where you can upload electronic copies of the document but it is not yet ready.
- 4) Once we have met you, we will complete your registration. The Certificate of Enrolment will be available a few hours' after we have formally enrolled you.

Important: If you have not met your academic conditions or return your completed university card form, please do so as a priority.

Use of Linacre College

You can start using Linacre College facilities from 20 Sept, including our common room.

Arrival arrangements at Farndon Court

Please note the <u>location for Farndon Court</u>. Have the map in hand in case the taxi driver does not know where it is. The entrance to Farndon Court is on Farndon Road.

If you are arriving at Farndon Court between 24 -27 Sept between 9-5pm, someone will be there to give you your room key, which is your university card.

If you are arriving on weekdays, Monday-Friday, 9-5pm, the caretaker, Ray Hall, will be at Farndon Court to give you your room key. He may not be at the reception all the time. If he is not there, please contact him at +44 (0)7564 045419.

If you are arriving outside 9-5pm and during the weekend (except 25 and 26 Sept where someone will be there), please collect your university card at Linacre College reception. If you are taking a taxi, please ask the driver to wait for you while you collect your card at Linacre College, and you can ask the driver to continue on to Farndon Court after you have collected your card. It is important for you to let us know when you arrive so that we can leave your card at Linacre College if you are not arriving during office hours.
